At a properly noticed and a quorum present at the Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4C (ANC4C) held on Tuesday, June 9, 2009, a resolution was presented by Commissioner Jones, SMD 4C08, seconded and voted unanimously by the Commission to adopt the following resolution of the Commission:

**WHEREAS:** the District of Columbia has a historic Homeowner Grant Program;

**WHEREAS:** low and moderate-income homeowners can receive a \$25,000 grant or a \$35,000 if the resident lives in Anacostia;

**WHEREAS;** the home must be in a historic District, and the property owner must receive a homestead exemption;

**WHEREAS:** many of these aging homes can be associated with historic persons and events;

**WHEREAS:** the District of Columbia has an aging housing stock and a rich history of persons and events;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** that the ANC 4C supports the expansion of the program to include eligible historic homes that have been designated as historic landmarks that are not in a historic district.
