Dear Ms. Miller:

At a properly noticed, and with a quorum present at the Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4C meeting held on May 12, 2009, a motion was presented by Commissioner Joseph Vaughan, seconded and passed seven (7) yes, one (1) no and one (1) abstention to support the special exception Case No. 17866 submitted by the Associates for Ideal Education, Inc.

Representatives from the Associates for Ideal Education, Inc., presented its' revised request for a special exception to the Commission including a presentation relative to the traffic study prepared in conjunction with the case. The Commission took particular note of the effort on the part of the Academy to apprise the community of the plan to establish a private school and that the scope of the operation had been scaled back to limit the number of students to no more than sixty (60). The Commission also recognized that some residents in the immediate area were not completely comfortable with the plan. Overall, however, the volatility connected with the issue had been significantly abated since the Academy first presented the project to the Commission in 2008.

Based on the foregoing, ANC 4C respectfully requests that the Board of Zoning Adjustment give great weight to the Commission's position to support the special exception Case No. 17866.
